

1 more held for Baksa killing



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JINTUL TALUKDAR, BAKSA: [Baksa police](#) have picked up one [more](#) person on Tuesday in connection with the recent incident where suspected [NDFB-S](#) militants four local lemon traders.

According to information, the person who was arrested on Tuesday morning is believed to have helped the [Bodo](#) militants [kidnapped](#) the local traders to be [killed](#). Police on Monday arrested three linkmen for helping militants.

On the other hand, the authorities have lifted the [curfew](#) during the day time from Tuesday. But [curfew](#) from 8 [PM](#) to 8 AM will continue in Gobardhana and Anand Bazar [police](#) stations in [Baksa](#) as well as the northern side of railway line in [Barpeta](#) district.

[Security forces](#) are continuing operations to arrest the culprits of the kidnap and murder.

Seven lemon traders, came to Labdanguri market in [Baksa](#) district from the adjacent [Barpeta](#) district, but four persons did not return home.

[Bodies](#) of [Ataur](#) Ali, Rubul Amin, Saddam Ali and Abu Bakkar -- were later fished out from Hakuwa river.

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
