14 days police remand for Paul

A lower court in Guwahati on Saturday remanded Dr Rakesh Paul ([/taxonomy/term/2168](#)) to 14 days police custody a day after the APSC chairman was arrested on corruption charges.

Amid heavy security, police produced Paul ([/taxonomy/term/2168](#)) before the CJM court in the Guwahati in the afternoon and sought 14 days remand saying that many stunning revelations would surface during the interrogation. But the courtallowed the police to keep Dr Paul ([/taxonomy/term/2168](#)) in 14 days custody.

Paul (/taxonomy/term/2168) was arrested in Dibrugarh on Friday morning and was brought to Guwahati for marathon interrogation in connection with a number of corruption charges against (/taxonomy/term/1929) him.

Many organizations and individuals have thronged the court premises as (/taxonomy/term/2291) the APSC boss (/taxonomy/term/2034) was brought. KMSS activists urged the court not to let him go on bail.

Many political leaders (/taxonomy/term/2082) have demanded exemplary punishment for Paul (/taxonomy/term/2168) for allowing APSC to mire in corruption.
