ABBYSF convention

The 7th Annual Convention of the All BTC Bengali Youth Students' Federation (ABBYSF) Central Committee and Udalguri (/taxonomy/term/113) district committee concluded at Tangla (/taxonomy/term/56) Model High School field with a three-day long programme from February (/taxonomy/term/1690)2 (/taxonomy/term/1690) to 4. On the concluding day clothes were distributed to poor people which was followed by a cultural procession that was taken out throughout the town where people of every community (/taxonomy/term/2084) participated. The procession was flagged off by Subir Das (/taxonomy/term/1926) social worker from Bijni (/taxonomy/term/1778). An open session was held today which was presided over (/taxonomy/term/2166) by Montu Dey President (/taxonomy/term/2432) of the central committee of the student (/taxonomy/term/2404) body.

Among other distinguished guests were Bikon Deka social worker, Likhon Das (/taxonomy/term/1926) Ainuddin Ahmed Vice-President (/taxonomy/term/2432) AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900), Lafiqul Islam General Secretary ABMSU, Kamali Rani Basumatari MLA Panery LAC, Maheswar Boro ex-MLA Kalaigaon LAC besides other. Speaking on the occasion Shymal Sarkar Adviser of the Central committee of the student (/taxonomy/term/2404) body said that Bengali Hindus (/taxonomy/term/2127) have sacrificed their life for the sake of nation but still Bengali's are harassed in the name of Bangladeshi. He said the government at the centre has given Indian citizenship (/taxonomy/term/2368) to Adnan Sami but had not given citizenship (/taxonomy/term/2368) to Hindu refugees (/taxonomy/term/2450). Sarkar also lashed Akhil Gogoi for his protest to deport Hindu Bangladeshis. He also remarked that the political leaders (/taxonomy/term/2082) who would raise their voice in Parliament (/taxonomy/term/1963) for the Bengali Hindus (/taxonomy/term/2127) would get their votes. He appealed every community (/taxonomy/term/2084) to remain united. Young journalist and writer (/taxonomy/term/2060) of Tangla (/taxonomy/term/56) Shajid Khan was also felicitated in the programme along with few other journalist.
