ABSU, NDFB (P) and PJACBM suspend bandh

In response to the letter issued by the Government of India ([/taxonomy/term/2367](#)) inviting the All Bodo Students Union (ABSU), Joint Action Committee for Bodoland Movement and the NDFB (P) for the Political ([/taxonomy/term/1692](#)) Level Tripartite talk to be held on the 25th April, 2017, in New Delhi ([/taxonomy/term/1868](#)), the Joint movement group ([/taxonomy/term/2415](#)) has temporarily suspended the 24hr proposed Bodoland Bandh called on 25th April 2017 in order to create a conducive atmosphere.

The Movement group (/taxonomy/term/2415) looks forward for a positive response from both the governments through the scheduled Political (/taxonomy/term/1692) level (/taxonomy/term/2232) tripartite talk after series of democratic mass movement since the NDA government came to power in 2014. The movement group (/taxonomy/term/2415) also anticipates a Permanent solution of the long pending Bodo Issue within short period for the interest of sustainable peace and all round development in the region.
