Achyut [Lahkar](#), the [father](#) of [Assamese](#) mobile theatre died on Sunday morning at around 7.30 am. Lahkar born in the year of 1931, founded the Nataraj Theatre, the first mobile theatre in Assam way back in 1963. Known [as](#) 'Mancha Pravakor' he was a pioneering dramatist, actor, director and producer who staged numerous memorable plays in mobile theatre.
