AGP, BPF want more berths: Mahanta

Amid growing speculations of cabinet reshuffle, AGP leader [\(/taxonomy/term/1820\)](/taxonomy/term/1820) Keshav Mahanta said his party should have more berth in the BJP-led coalition government.
