AGP divided over Mahanta's quit

A divided AGP ([/taxonomy/term/482](#)) on Tuesday failed to take the final ([/taxonomy/term/488](#)) call on Prafulla Kumar Mahanta's resignation as party ([/taxonomy/term/1381](#)) president.

Mahanta's close associates wanted him to stay citing collective responsibility for the recent Lok Sabha ([/taxonomy/term/1215](#)) poll ([/taxonomy/term/498](#)) debacle while another ([/taxonomy/term/1365](#)) circle of party ([/taxonomy/term/1381](#)) leaders strongly advocated change of guard.

The general assembly of the party (/taxonomy/term/1381) which met at its headquarters in the evening resolved to take a decision after a series of consultation with district level workers.

Presided over working president Atul Bora, the meeting (/taxonomy/term/791) decided to hold a political convention on October 14.

Party leaders told Assam (/taxonomy/term/548) Times that the meeting (/taxonomy/term/791) will discuss with the various regional parties and organizations, the strategies to further strengthen the regional party (/taxonomy/term/1381).
