

Ailing regionalism: AGP leader joins BJP



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Dark clouds are hovering [over](#) the regionalism in Assam politics when one after another AGP [leaders](#) are joining BJP. That too hardly a year before the assembly polls.

Yet another AGP [leader](#) joined the saffrone party on Sunday. He is none other than Jagadish Bhuyan.

The former minister joined the national politics at a function attended by state unit president Siddharth Bhattacharya in the BJP party office in Guwahati.

Apart from Bhuyan, former [AJYCP](#) president [Manoj](#) Baruah is set to join the national politics next week. Baruah formally quit the organization on Sunday.

This would be followed by the joining of two former AASU [leaders](#) Tapan Kumar Gogoi and [Sankar](#) Prasad Ray. Much to utter disappointment, more and more AGP and [AJYCP leaders](#) are believed to have been preparing to join BJP.

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
