

## AIPSN Assam launches state-level 'Future of India' campaign



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**GUWAHATI, July 15, 2026** — The Assam unit of the All India People's Science Network (AIPSN), in collaboration with Ellora Vigyan Mancha, CRU (NER), and Gyan-Vigyan Samiti Assam, launched the state-level phase of the nationwide 'Future of India' campaign on July 14.

The campaign, scheduled to run until May 1, 2027, aims to raise awareness on issues including healthcare access, quality education, agricultural challenges, food security, climate change, and sustainable development.

The inaugural programme was presided over by Er. Khanin Talukdar, while Dr. Jili Bordoloi delivered the welcome address. Er.
