Ambubachi fair ends

Kamakhya temple ([/taxonomy/term/1876](#)) premises atop the Neelacjhal hill is set to be fallen silent on Friday as the four day long Ambubachi fair has come to an end.

Lakhs of pilgrims ([/taxonomy/term/2233](#)) from the country and abroad are waiting on long queues from early in the morning to visit the ancient temple ([/taxonomy/term/1876](#)) which resumed puja offerings on Friday.
