

Assam colleges opt for Open Source Software, get trained



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In an effort in the region to acquire skills in the use of Free / Libre and Open Source Software (FLOSS) Assam [state](#) has set the [trend](#) by sending representatives from colleges in all 27 districts for a [training workshop](#) organized by the first private university in the [state](#).

“After promoting FLOSS right from the [start](#) of the university since 2008, today it is a dream come true for us to host faculty from colleges representing all 27 districts of the [state](#),” says Pro Vice-Chancellor of Assam [Don Bosco](#) University ([ADBU](#)) Fr Joseph Nellanattu, a FLOSS apostle.

Sessions include lectures on Spoken Tutorial project, Linux Operating [System](#) basics and installation, and hands on session in Libre Office.

At the end of the [workshop](#), besides certificates of participation for all participants, all 27 knowledge centers will receive a book on FLOSS [as](#) well [as](#) DVDs with Spoken [Tutorials](#).

The Spoken Tutorial Project is about teaching and learning a particular FLOSS like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHP & MySQL, Java, C/C++, Libre Office etc. via an easy video tool - Spoken [Tutorials](#).
