

Assembly adjourns sine die



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The [Assam](#) Legislative assembly adjourned sine die on [Saturday](#) after holding 27 day long budget session.

The session began on August [4](#) last where chief minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) who holds the finance [portfolio](#) tabled the Rs 1385.77 crore [deficit](#) budget which got cleared.

The session was extended by a day to discuss the [Assam](#)-Nagaland [border](#) flare up and the shocking murder of [school](#) girl in Chirang by NDFB(S). But the discussion was not allowed citing it a sub judice matters.
