Baksa celebrates World Red Cross Day

The spirit of celebration of the World Red Cross Day ([/taxonomy/term/2143](#)) on May 8 culminated with homage to Sir Jean Henry Dunant, the founder of the Red Cross Movement, worldwide.

In Baksa, in Assam, the Indian Red Cross Society organized various activities close to its theme "The Fundamental Principles in Action," at the Arnabil High School ([/taxonomy/term/2145](#)), in Bhutankhuti ([/taxonomy/term/2144](#)) near Indo-Bhutan border.
