Bamboo bridge at Aie-polly village

Villagers of bordering areas of Dadgiri along Indo-Bhutan border in Chirang district, hit by the heaviest flood during the month of June -July last, is still finding difficult to get back into normalcy in their day to day life. Besides various aid programmes, like relief material distribution received from district administration & SSB, local villagers along with BOPs of 16th battalion(Bn) SSB jointly putting efforts to repair all the damaged temporary assets like bamboo ([/taxonomy/term/2380](#)) bridges which were drowned due to heavy flood and hampered the connectivity's among the villagers along border areas.

Once again 16th Bn SSB Ranighuli step forward to assist the villagers, a bamboo (/taxonomy/term/2380) bridge has been constructed at Aie-polly village by joint efforts of personnel of BOP Aie- polly under company headquarter(Coy HQR), Dadgiri of 16battalion of SSB with the assistance of villagers of Aie-polly village .

The bridge plays vital role for connectivity among nearby villages of Dadgiri & same was damaged due to heaviest flood occurred during the month of June-July. BOP also contributed some money and spent over (/taxonomy/term/2166) construction of bamboo (/taxonomy/term/2380) binding wire and providing refreshment to the villagers during the constructions.
