Bandh supportrs burns tyres

AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) activists burnt motor tyres at Makrapara along JD Road in Kokrajhar during (/taxonomy/term/2005)10 (/taxonomy/term/2005)-hours Assam bandh (/taxonomy/term/100) called AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) in protest against (/taxonomy/term/1929) killed two persons and injured several during eviction drive at Kaziranga (/taxonomy/term/122) yesterday. On the other hand, Kokrajhar saw a partial bandh (/taxonomy/term/100) response as (/taxonomy/term/2291) bazaar, school, colleges and most of the public and private vehicles run as (/taxonomy/term/2291) usual since morning on the day.

AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) called (/taxonomy/term/2005) **10** (/taxonomy/term/2005)–hours Assam bandh (/taxonomy/term/100) in protest against (/taxonomy/term/1929) Kaziranga (/taxonomy/term/122) eviction which had claimed two lives and some others received injuries in the eviction drive carried out yesterday along the Bandordubi area.

The bandh (/taxonomy/term/100) was started from (/taxonomy/term/2015) **6** (/taxonomy/term/2015) am and conclude by 4 pm in the evening.

Bandh supporters burnt motor tyres at Makrapara along JD Road in protest against (/taxonomy/term/1929) eviction and shouted slogans against (/taxonomy/term/1929) state (/taxonomy/term/2332) government, demanded early stop (/taxonomy/term/2235) of eviction and stop (/taxonomy/term/2235) atrocities on innocent Muslim (/taxonomy/term/2482) peoples in the name of eviction.

Kokrajhar saw a partial response during bandh (/taxonomy/term/100) hours, bazaar, market, school, colleges, most of the government office and public-private vehicles run as (/taxonomy/term/2291) usual on the day. It is to be noted that public and citizens come out to the bazaar and market for marketing (/taxonomy/term/133).

‘Provide sufficient compensation (/taxonomy/term/1699) and ex-gratia to the affected victims (/taxonomy/term/1810) families’, AAMSU (/taxonomy/term/1900) demanded.
