

BJP seeks executive seat in BTC



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The ruling alliance partner at Dispur, the BPF and BJP today held a joint meeting at Bodoland guest House in Kokrajhar involving party [leader](#) and members from four districts of BTAD region. The Assam Pradesh BJP seek a post of executive member in BTC executive council for Dharma Narayan [Das](#), who is sitting BTC [MCLA](#) from saffron party in the council.

The joint meeting in between BPF and BJP thoroughly discussed on communication building in between two parties in the region besides sharing of development works in volving party [workers](#) in the council region. The BJP submitted a seeking letter to [Hagrama Mohilary](#), BPF president, who is also BTC [chief](#) to induct Dharma Narayan [Das as](#) Executive Member in BTC executive council to pave way healthy integration under the spirit of allianc at the Dispur.
