Brisk polling in Boithalangu

Amid huge security around 1,80,203 electorates are voting in Boithalangu to elect a new MLA on Saturday.

The polling was not brisk early in the morning when it started at [7](#) in the morning. But more and more people started making long queues in front of the 246 booths where polling will continue till 4 in the afternoon where three candidates are on the fray.

The main contest confines to Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) and BJP. But Independent candidate Raju Rongpi is no less popular who is expected to make big dents in BJP and Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) pockets. Mansing Rongpi is BJP candidate who won the seat with Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) ticket in the last assembly polls. Rongpi locks horns with Rupamsing Ronghung whom Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) allowed to contest the by polls.

The poll panel is holding the by polls since Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) MLA Mansing Rongpi left the party and joined BJP.
