

CBI unhappy with Bajaj-Sada statements



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The preliminary stage of [interrogation ends](#). The [CBI team](#) probing the multi crore [Saradha scam](#) has allowed Sadananda [Gogoi](#) and Rajesh Bajaj to go from Kolkata office.

But sources say that the country's premier investigation agency is not so satisfied with their revelations during the first round of [interrogation](#) at CGO Complex at Salt Lake in Kolkata.

[Gogoi](#), the filmmaker Sadananda [Gogoi](#) who took [money](#) from [Saradha](#) for making an ad film apart from his role in the a few dirty deals between [Saradha](#) boss and a circle of [Guwahati](#) based polwerful political leaders, was interrogated thrice.

Bajaj, ensured the dirty deal between Sen and Matang Sinh for investment in a [Guwahati](#) based news channel was interrogated for fifth [time](#) on [Sunday](#).

The [CBI team](#) is preparing an interim to its Central office with details such as those arrested, questioned, places it raided and seizures made.

In his purported letter, Sudipta Sen had told [CBI](#) that he did not get [back](#) Rs 28 crore from Matang Sinh after the deal between him and former Union minister to takeover of a news channel.

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
