Chopper wreckage found in Thinsa

The wreckage of the Pawan Hans helicopter Tirap (/taxonomy/term/2186) Deputy Commissioner Kamalesh Joshi (/taxonomy/term/2203) was found (/taxonomy/term/1802) at a remote area of Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh where it crash landed on Tuesday.

The rescue operation made with three choppers along with a Sukhoi Jet locate the wreckage at Thinsa in the wee hours tracing a phone calls from Joshi (/taxonomy/term/2203) to his wife at (/taxonomy/term/1690)2 (/taxonomy/term/1690) – (/taxonomy/term/2005)10 (/taxonomy/term/2005) in the afternoon. Senior officials arrived in the crash site and recovered the decomposed bodies in the morning.

The chopper went missing on Tuesday on its way to Khunsa from Longding. The last contact was established at 11-30 with Mohanbari airport. Initially, the search operation was concentrated at an area near Dalom where a section of local residents claimed to have heard the sound of a huge explosion in the sky.

But rescuers failed to trace it even after deployment of a Sukhoi Jet along with three other helicopters during the last six days.
