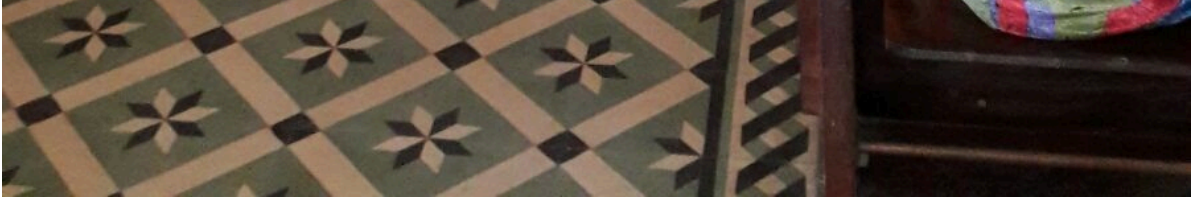

Christmas celebrated in Tangla
