Christmas celebrations in peak

Christmas (/taxonomy/term/75) festivity (/taxonomy/term/2455) grips Assam on Sunday where churches across the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) pulled huge crowd of people who participated in the special prayer in search of global peace.

Defying a pinching cold wave the Christian people of all walks of life thronged the church premises' for the special prayer in the morning.

People in large number in the north eastern city (/taxonomy/term/1957) of Guwahati rushed to the Panbajar based Baptist church in the morning after the end of the midnight carol to mark the birth (/taxonomy/term/2090) of the Jesus.

Similar rush of people was in sight at the Don Bosco (/taxonomy/term/2412) premises and the Christianbast Church where the people held special prayer in search of divine help to restore global peace.

Braving a cold evening on Saturday hundreds of people thronged the church premises' in different places across the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) where they participated in the midnight carol which ended in the morning with the participators wishing each others a happy Christmas (/taxonomy/term/75).
