

CLP met cancelled



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The [Congress](#) legislative body has cancelled its meeting slated for September [2](#). The decision was taken when a section of cabinet ministers and MLAs met [chief](#) minister [Tarun Gogoi](#) at his official residence in Koindhara on Saturday evening.

Earlier, the party legislators decided to hold an emergency meeting to discuss the post-Himanta exit situation on August 29 to be rescheduled to September [2](#). But it has been cancelled.

The cabinet ministers further apprised the [chief](#) minister of their measures to implement the various schemes.

Gogoi asked them to expedite the implementation process to ensure that these can percolate benefit for the people.

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
