

CM orders probe against Chirang police



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Chief Minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) on Monday announced a thorough probe into the allegations of [police](#) inaction in the Priya Basumatary [killing](#) case six days [back](#).

According to [allegation](#), while Priya was [killed](#) on August 20 afternoon, the [police](#) never went to Dwimuguri along the Indo-[Bhutan border](#) where the murder took place.

Only the villagers recovered her [body](#) next day and handed it over to the [police](#) at [Salbari](#). [Gogoi](#) said that Priya was not a [police](#) informer.

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
