

College girl abducted at Dimakuchi

In a sensational case of suspected '[Love Jihadi](#)' activity, a fourth semi star college going girl of [Dimakuchi](#) college in [Udalguri](#) district has been missing since May 31. According to information one Sangeeta Deka (20), daughter of Jadu Deka and Chitra Deka of village No. 2 Sonajuli under [Dimakuchi](#) police station had been abducted by one Sahabul Haque, son of Suraj Ali of the village Santipukhuri in Darrang district on May 31. According to Chitra Deka, mother of the girl, the abductor Sahabul Haque had maintained an affair with her daughter pretending to be a unmarried educated youth. After the abduction only his real identity was known that he was a married [Muslim driver](#) by profession having wife and children. The mother alleges that FIR was lodged at [Dimakuchi](#) police station, but no action has been taken by police for her rescue.
