Cong, LDP target Governor Rajkhowa

BJP received a severe jolt when the Supreme Court on Wednesday ordered immediate restoration of the Nabam (/taxonomy/term/2429) Tuki Government in Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh a couple of months after he was dislodged by Kalikho Pul with the help of BJP. Now many political parties and individuals have asked Governor (/taxonomy/term/2435) JP Rajkhowa (/taxonomy/term/2396) to quit the job (/taxonomy/term/2438).

Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) veteran and former Assam Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi (/taxonomy/term/2150) welcomed the SC ruling while state (/taxonomy/term/2332) Congress (/taxonomy/term/90) interim president Ripun Bora (/taxonomy/term/1799) demanded the immediate resignation of Governor (/taxonomy/term/2435) JP Rajkhowa (/taxonomy/term/2396) for his misleading role.

In his facebook post Liberal Democratic Party leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) Prodyut Bora (/taxonomy/term/1799) said, “the Supreme Court has ended the machinations of the Modi government and Governor (/taxonomy/term/2435) JP Rajkhowa (/taxonomy/term/2396), and restored the Nabam (/taxonomy/term/2429) Tuki government in Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh. In his historic ruling, the five-judge Constitution bench said, “the Governor (/taxonomy/term/2435) must remain aloof from any disagreement, discord, disharmony, discontent or dissension, within individual political parties.” Rajkhowa (/taxonomy/term/2396), the former Assam Chief Secretary is on leave where Tripura (/taxonomy/term/1738) Governor (/taxonomy/term/2435) T Roy (/taxonomy/term/1639) has been holding the charge.
