Congress party workers meet in Batadrava

With the panchayat poll is just a couple of months away, Along with rest of the state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#)), the major opposition party Congress ([/taxonomy/term/90](#)) has started preparing blueprints in Batadrava legislative Constituency which falls under both Nagaon and Morigaon ([/taxonomy/term/101](#)) district to outsmart in upcoming election.
