North East ([/taxonomy/term/2419](#)) Union of Working Journalists ([/taxonomy/term/2506](#)) (NEUWJ) expresses its worry over ([/taxonomy/term/2166](#)) the sudden closure of Janasadharan (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Janasadharan> (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Janasadharan>)), an Assamese ([/taxonomy/term/2159](#)) daily published simultaneously from Guwahati and Dibrugarh, since 19 November ([/taxonomy/term/1961](#)) 2016 ([/taxonomy/term/1961](#)) and urged the management to continue publishing the newspaper.

For any unwanted reason, if the management cannot republish the newspaper, the NEUWJ demands [\(/taxonomy/term/2467\)](#) legal compensations to each and every employee of the media house.
