

CPM withdraws candidate in Charilam by poll

AGARTALA: In a bizarre move, the [Left](#) Front in [Tripura](#) has withdrawn its candidate fielded for the Charilam constituency by election alleging an orgy of post poll violence two days ahead of the polls. This was more or less of what CPIM [leader](#) Gautam [Das](#) said in Agaratla on Saturday.
