

Curfew in Golaghat; 3 killed in firing



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Yet [another](#) place in [Golaghat](#) turned into a battle field on [Wednesday](#) after the Rangajan [tragedy](#).

Three people were [killed](#) and at least [30](#) others sustained injury when security [forces](#) sprang upon a huge crowd of protesters in [Golaghat](#) district on [Wednesday](#).

The incident took place at Erengapar area when a section of people who took to the streets in [protest](#) against the Rangajan [police](#) excess, clashed with the security [forces](#) who tried to quell them.

The situation suddenly took a worse turn when a section of the protestors allegedly attacked the security [forces](#). Then [police](#) and [CRPF](#) jawans resorted to open firing at the protestors leaving at least 10 seriously [injured](#).

Four protesters succumbed to injuries at the Kushal [Konwar](#) Civil Hospital while at least 20 others have been battling for life.

The district administration has clamped indefinite [curfew](#) in the entire disturbed area to prevent the people from staging paralyzing [protest](#).

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
