Don't speak ill of China: ULFA-I to Dalai Lama

ULFA (/taxonomy/term/124)'s Paresh Baruah faction has asked the Dalai Lama not to speak ill of China during his upcoming visit to Assam.

In a statement, ULFA (/taxonomy/term/124)(I) chairman Dr Abhijit Asom (/taxonomy/term/2581) said that his anti-China remarks on the soil of Assam might trigger a 1962 like aggression on the state (/taxonomy/term/2332). He made it plain that ULFA (/taxonomy/term/124)-I has nothing to oppose Dalai Lama's visit to the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) if he tries to revive the Buddhist culture which existed in the ancient Assam.
