

Eerie calm in Golaghat



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The uneasy situation refuses to die down in [Golaghat](#) a day after three people were [killed](#) in [clash](#) with security [forces](#).

The [Army](#) is holding a flag march in violence hit areas to bring the situation under control a day after the administration clamped [curfew](#) in some sensitive pockets.

People in many places thronged in thousands in [protest](#) against the [police](#) firing on [Tuesday](#) and [Wednesday](#). In the tea garden areas, [armed](#) with bows and arrows a section [bandh](#) supporters blocked the roads.

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
