### Election steering office inaugurated

The wave of election steering committee office inauguration and campaigning from several regional and national parties including BPF,BJP,PCDR gain momentum in BTC region to contest scheduled council election declared to be held on April 8 next.

Former Rajya Sabha MP and adviser of Peoples Coordination for Democratic Rights(PCDR),a united organisation of various communities inaugurated the Kokrajhar district election steering committee office of PCDR today at Mijink Nwgwr along the JD Road in Kokrajhar.

Brahma in his speech said that the PCDR has been contesting in all constituencies of BTC election scheduled on April 8 next to meet good governance and change of social integration. He said that the PCDR is getting majority support from all sections of communities in large number of constituencies and way of council formation formation is cent percent clear after April 11.
