

Festivity in Nagaland township



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Ahuna festival fetched no less pomp and gaiety to the people of Zunheboto on Monday as the township turned 75.

Addressing the mammoth gathering on the occasion at Public Ground this morning, Chief Minister TR Zeliang termed the day as a '[Red Letter Day](#)' and extended warm greetings on behalf of the government of [Nagaland](#).

From today, he said, Zunheboto which is known as the 'land of warriors' be changed and called as the 'land of peace and prosperity'.
