Fisherman nets rare fish in Namrup

A rare black thorn fish pulled huge crowd after it was rescued
(/taxonomy/term/1630) at a local market in Namrup on Monday which later was
rescued (/taxonomy/term/1630) for proper conservation by thr forest department.

The unique creature of 30 cm length was brought to the BVFCL namghar chariali by a retailer Dipankar Gogoi who procured it from a local fisherman. The fisherman is believed to have caught [\(/taxonomy/term/2308\)](#) it in a deep drain at Sonari tiniali.
