Flood woes hit 3 districts

Flood waters ([/taxonomy/term/2337](#)) start ([/taxonomy/term/1707](#)) taking a grim turn in Assam on Monday following heavy downpour during the last couple of days in the catchment areas in Arunachal ([/taxonomy/term/2194](#)) Pradesh. The situation is set to take more grim turn if the rains that lash the entire state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#)) refuse to relent during the next couple of days.

The mighty Brahmaputra (/taxonomy/term/2226) along with its subsidiaries have been flowing dangerously leaving around one lakh people marooned in Lakhimpur, Dhemaji and Sonitpur districts. The surging waters (/taxonomy/term/2337) are learnt to have inundated at least 200 villages in the three districts damaging crops on a huge area measuring 1,500 hectares.

More and more revenue villages are said to have come under the surging waters (/taxonomy/term/2337) where the major rivers have started flowing above the danger (/taxonomy/term/1965) level (/taxonomy/term/2232). The district administrations have stepped up relief and rescue in the flood hit areas with essential commodities.
