Flood wreaks havoc in Kaziranga

Flood waters are wreaking havoc in Kaziranga (/taxonomy/term/122) National Park. The famed abode of the one- horned rhino has come under the surging waters after the river Brahmaputra started flowing above the danger level.

Park authorities told Assam (/taxonomy/term/548) Times that the flood (/taxonomy/term/1231) inundated low-lying areas in almost all the ranges with the animals moving to the highlands in neighbouring Karbi (/taxonomy/term/565) Anglong district.

Water (/taxonomy/term/796) has entered 50 (/taxonomy/term/1413) camps across the Park with three camps evacuated in the Northern range.

The flood (/taxonomy/term/1231) have forced many birds and animals to be migrated to the highland across NH (/taxonomy/term/1379)-37.

To check speeding vehicles barricades have been set up and time-cards introduced to control the speed of the vehicles.
