

Gogoi proposes dredging corp



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Chief Minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) on Monday proposed a Dredging Corporation to firmly deal with the perennial [flood](#) and erosion problems in the state.

In his budget speech, [Gogoi](#) said that this will be apart from recommendations for 41 [Centre](#)-funded schemes worth Rs [1,387](#) crore.

He said," in view of the critical erosion problem, channelisation of [River](#) Brahmaputra, Barak and its tributaries and reclamation of lost land has become highly necessary. I propose to set up a Dredging Corporation for this purpose."

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
