

Gogoi to table state budget on Monday

Assam Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi is all set to table the state budget for 2011-2012 on the day one of the budget session on Monday. The ten day long session will also hold debate on the budget on July 14 and 15.

Policemen are building big barricades in and around the Last Gate where the various organizations are set to stage demonstration raising their demands.
