

Goodwill mission visits victims house killed at Srirampur

A “Goodwill Mission” headed by Thanesar Malakar,DC,Udalguri visited various villages of Bhergaon sub-division including the house of Nabla Boro (35) son of Kulen Boro of Khagrabari Nalbari village on July 26. Nabla Boro, a CRPF jawan serving under 151 BN CRPF at Jammu had been brutally killed by miscreants at Srirampur railway station on July 23 while he was returning to the place of his posting after spending a months leave at home. On behalf of the district administration, DC Malakar offered deep condolence to the family members of the victim. He also offered financial assistance to the family. Other distinguished members of the mission were- Nilakanta Gayari, president district Bodo Sahitya Sabha; Benjamin Soren, advisor, All India Santhali Sahitya Sabha etc beside representatives of AASU, ABSU, AGSU, AASA, etc.
