### Guru Nanak jayanti celebrated in Tangla

The 547th birth (/taxonomy/term/2090) anniversary (/taxonomy/term/2091) of Guru Nanak, the founder of Sikhism, was celebrated (/taxonomy/term/2092) in Tangla (/taxonomy/term/56) along with the rest of India (/taxonomy/term/2367) on Wednesday. Special preparations were made for the day in the local gurdwara to celebrate the birth (/taxonomy/term/2090) anniversary (/taxonomy/term/2091) of the first guru of the Sikh religion, which falls on the day of Kartik Purnima every year. In Tangla (/taxonomy/term/56) the followers of the religion made a beeline to the gurdwaras since morning and took part in langar (community (/taxonomy/term/2084) lunch), a tradition started by Guru Nanak to encourage brotherhood and fellow feeling among all sections, irrespective of caste and creed.
