Hagrama demands probe

BTC chief (/taxonomy/term/2020) Hagrama Mohilary (/taxonomy/term/1896) demanded high level (/taxonomy/term/2232) inquiry and punishment of involved culprits with AASU office vandalised yesterday at Shilapothar in Dhemaji district.
