Half citizens in Arunachal to come to Assam!

Prabajan Virodhi Manch, a social organization against the immigration issue, has raised serious concern over (/taxonomy/term/2166) the Centre's decision to grant (/taxonomy/term/2065) citizenship to the Chakma (/taxonomy/term/2481) and Hajong refugees (/taxonomy/term/2450) in Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh.

The convener of the organization Upomanyu Hazarika (/taxonomy/term/2576) said on Saturday that finally, these refugees (/taxonomy/term/2450)' would come to Assam since Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh has announced no land rights (/taxonomy/term/1990) to these people who migrated from the Chittagang Hills Tracks.

He appreciated the Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh leadership for half citizenship formula to these Chakma (/taxonomy/term/2481) and Hajong refugees (/taxonomy/term/2450) after the Supreme court asked the Centre to grant (/taxonomy/term/2065) them citizenship triggering massive protest across the north eastern state (/taxonomy/term/2332).

Hazarika (/taxonomy/term/2576), who is a senior lawyer said why the leadership has not been taking any lesson from the Arunachal (/taxonomy/term/2194) Pradesh counterpart as it has been grappling with the Bangladeshi immigrants issue.

The Supreme Court very recently asked the Centre to grant (/taxonomy/term/2065) citizenship to the Chakma (/taxonomy/term/2481) and Hajong refugees (/taxonomy/term/2450) much to the major concern for the people who have been dead opposed to thr idea and the state (/taxonomy/term/2332) leadership has prevailed upon the formula of half citizenship where these new citizens would not have the land rights (/taxonomy/term/1990).
