According to locals, Abinash nath, son of Mohan nath of Pahupurikhaiti under Raha police station was a Class [X student](#) of Phulaguri Sankardev Sishu vidya niketan. [Eye](#) Witness said, the tregedy struck Abhinash while crossing the NH37 with earphones plugged in. He was on his way to his tuition classes riding his bycycle in the morning.
