India, Burma agree for border security coordination

India (/taxonomy/term/2367) and Burma (Myanmar (/taxonomy/term/2252)) agreed for close security coordination in border areas keeping in view the sensitivity of each other's strategic interests. In a press statement after holding delegation level (/taxonomy/term/2232) talks with visiting Myanmar (/taxonomy/term/2252) State Counsellor Daw Aung San Suu Kyi in New Delhi (/taxonomy/term/1868) on 19 October (/taxonomy/term/1961) 2016 (/taxonomy/term/1961), Prime Minister Narendra Modi (/taxonomy/term/2361) said, as (/taxonomy/term/2291) a reliable partner and friend, India (/taxonomy/term/2367) stands shoulder to shoulder with Myanmar (/taxonomy/term/2252).

PM Modi added that the two neighboring countries agreed to enhance engagement in several areas including agriculture (/taxonomy/term/2418), power, and renewable energy. New Delhi (/taxonomy/term/1868) and NayPieTaw will also work to develop a mutually beneficial arrangement for trade (/taxonomy/term/1790) in pulses, added Modi. India (/taxonomy/term/2367) offered to enhance power supply from Moreh in Manipur (/taxonomy/term/64) of northeast India (/taxonomy/term/2367) to Myanmar (/taxonomy/term/2252)'s Tamu town. Archaeological Survey (/taxonomy/term/2384) of India (/taxonomy/term/2367) will soon (/taxonomy/term/2206) begin work on restoring two old temples and inscriptions of King Mindon and King Baygyidaw in Bodh Gaya of Bihar, said the statement.

Ms Suu Kyi, who is recognized as (/taxonomy/term/2291) the democratic icon in her country, stated that Burma admires India (/taxonomy/term/2367) for being the greatest democracy in the world. She hoped that India (/taxonomy/term/2367) could help Burma with its experiences in different field of activities to overcome numerous challenges.
