

KMSS resumes anti big dam protest

After a brief halt, Lakhimpur and Dhemaji districts erupted in anti big dam protest when thousands of people blockaded supply of materials meant from the NHPC-owned mega dams in Guwahati. Spearheaded by KMSS and AASU, the protesters in thousands are holding protests along the National Highway No 52 to prevent rush of trucks carrying machineries to Guwahati.

KMSS and AASU leaders said that they will not allow any vehicle to bound for Gerukamukh based NHPC-owned project. KMSS leader Akhil Gogoi said that they would intensify the protest against the mega dams now under construction which would have adverse impact on the downstream areas.

Notably, KMSS called off the stir for two days Saturday and Sunday waiting for Government response. But that has not happened.
