KMSS stages strike in Guwahati

The protest over [\(/taxonomy/term/2166\)](#) the refugee status to the Bangladeshi Hindu nations gathers momentum when KMSS leaders [\(/taxonomy/term/2082\)](#) started staging fast unto death in Guwahati on Monday.

Led by Akhil Gogoi, many KMSS activists thronged beside the Dighalipukhuri at [\(/taxonomy/term/2005\)](#) [10 \(/taxonomy/term/2005\)](#) in the morning and the started the fast unto death saying that Assam will not be allowed to be a dumping ground of the Bangladeshi nationals.

Talking to Assam Times, KMSS leaders (/taxonomy/term/2082) said, “This is not the way. Why Assam is allowed to be a dumping ground. We the people are not prepared to bear the burden of more Bangaldeshi people. We are ready to face any eventuality.”

KMSS leader (/taxonomy/term/1820) Akhil Gogoi is believed to have been trying to rope in more and more organizations, giant leaders (/taxonomy/term/2082) and intellectuals to oppose the Centre’s move to accord refugee status to the neighbouring nationals.
