Lifer for 4 by Udalguri Court

The District and Sessions court of Udalguri ([/taxonomy/term/113](#)) on Friday sentenced four persons, including a women who were accused in a murder of a farmer ([/taxonomy/term/2478](#)) at Dimakuchi ([/taxonomy/term/1706](#)) under Panery police station in Udalguri ([/taxonomy/term/113](#)) district. The four accused are Nagen Deka,Gahin Deka,Sarat Deka and Pranita Deka,who severely beat one Sukeswar Medhi a farmer ([/taxonomy/term/2478](#)) at his paddy field way back on July 4 in 2007 leading to his death.

Ritamoni Medhi wife of the deceased lodged an FIR at the then Dimakuchi (/taxonomy/term/1706) police outpost and a case was registered under Panery PS. The court headed by district and Sessions judge AK Borah came out with a verdict on Friday and sentenced the four accused with life imprisonment under sections 147/447/325/302 of the IPC.
