M'laya permits coal transportation again

In a move that defies the Supreme Court order, the Meghalaya ([/taxonomy/term/2343](#)) Government has issued permission again to transport coals in the state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#)). In its modified order, the NPP-led coalition Government permitted coal transportation triggering protest from the opposition parties and organizations.

The apex court on January 15 asked the state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#)) to ban on coal transportation after the coal-mine tragedy where as many as 20 miners were believed to have trapped inside a flooded mine in East Jaintia District.

The government issued order to implement the top court order. But suddenly on Sunday, the government modified the order allowing the transportation of coal.
