### Make public Naga peace pact: AASSA to PM

**TINSUKIA:** The All Adivasi ([/taxonomy/term/2018](#)) Students Association of Assam (AASSAA ([/taxonomy/term/2064](#))) staged sit in for two hours in Tinsukia ([/taxonomy/term/84](#)) demanding that the Centre must make public the Naga peace framework to allay the apprehension of the state ([/taxonomy/term/2332](#))'s territorial integration.

Talking to Assam Times, AASSA president Raja Kujur, General Secretary Ramanuj Lakra said the silence of the Assam Government over [the recent Nagaland](#) [sub division](#) on the soil of Assam, deterioration of law and order situation along the Assam-Nagaland [border](#) have raised doubt [over](#) [the role of the Government at the Centre and state](#).

They made it clear that the Government would be responsible for any untoward incident if takes place after the announcement of the greater Nagalim. Later they sent a memorandum to the Prime Minister through the Deputy Commissioner raising their demands [\(taxonomy/term/2467\)](#).
