Golaghat Police today apprehended a dreaded Maoist [leader](#) from Khakandguri under Dergaon. The arrested cadre has been identified [as](#) Pallav Charingia Phukan alias Akon alias Phukan who hails from [Tinsukia](#) and working [as](#) an organiser with the banned organisation. Police sources said that Pallav Charingia Phukan along with his associates were organising a meeting at a place in Khakandguri. Acting on a tip off a special team of Golaghat police led by Additional SP Numal Mahto raided the spot and apprehended the Maoist. However two other cadres namely Diganta Thamong of [Arunachal](#) Pradesh and Bikash of Karbi Anglong were managed to escape from the spot. In the meeting plannings were made for [Rhino](#) poaching with the help of Naga extremists which unveils the Maoist organisation's link with other insurgents groups in the [North East](#). It is to be mentioned that Golaghat police apprehended the most wanted Maoist [leader Aditya Bora](#) from the same place last month.
